**SUBJECT- NUTRITION & BIOCHEMISTRY** 

**CODE: BSN 102** 

**Course Outcomes:**

biochemistry in diseases for practice of nursing and to assist the students to acquire

knowledge of nutrition for maintenance of optimum health at different stages of life and its

application for practice of nursing. It provides the students with a wide knowledge of

dietetics in Indian setting, that the practice of teaching optimum and realistic dietary

planning can become an integral part of nursing practice.

# SUBJECT- MEDICAL SURGICAL NURSING Subject Code- BSN 301

CO5. Apply the nursing process in the care of patients with mental disorders in hospital and

community and creates the awareness in community.

SUBJECT- NURSING RESEARCH AND STATISTICS

**CODE: BSN 304** 

Course Outcome -

of research and statistics, use the findings of nursing research in nursing practice, apply the

knowledge in conducting project(s) and solve problems related to nursing using scientific

method.

# B.SC. NURSING 4<sup>TH</sup> YEAR

#### SUBJECT- MIDWIFERY AND OBSTETRICAL NURSING

CODE: BSN 401
